Essential Duties include:

- Demonstrate, exemplify and support the Capuchin Charism and Provincial Mission, Vision and Values throughout all professional responsibilities and activities
- Assist in unloading of food products from delivery vehicles when necessary
- Assist guests with the shopping process
- Assist in the safe storage of food products
- Stock foods items as needed or directed
- Sort, grade and categorize clothing
- Evaluate donated household items
- Assist in preparation of materials for the Capuchin Shower Program
- Other tasks as assigned

Qualifications: The desired education and experience level for this position is a High School diploma or GED. Ability to bend, lift and carry at least 50 pounds. Must be willing to obtain a Serve Safe Certificate. Ability to read, write and follow detailed oral and written instructions in English. Ability to maintain cooperative working relationships with management, co-workers and guests to the Soup Kitchen.

Hours are 5 days a week, 8:30am – 4:30pm with potential for extra hours. 40 hours/week
