

Security/Site Host/Driver – Full Time Capuchin Community Services

Inspired by the gospel of Jesus and the example of Francis of Assisi, the Capuchin friars of the Province of St. Joseph, together with our partners in ministry, prayerfully build sister-brotherhood in the world. We attend simply and directly to the spiritual and other basic human needs, especially those of the poor and disenfranchised, promoting justice for all.

Capuchin Community Services, with two sites in Milwaukee, assists those with basic subsistence needs (food, clothing etc.). The Security/Site Host is responsible for assisting in the daily operations of both locations, the House of Peace and St. Ben's Community Meal, and maintain a safe and hospitable environment for guests, volunteers and employees.

Responsibilities:

- Demonstrate, exemplify and support the Capuchin Charism and Provincial Mission, Vision and Values throughout all professional responsibilities and activities
- Greet guests and guide them to appropriate service
- Ensure all guests demonstrate appropriate behavior; communicate any issues with Assistant Director
- Ask guests who are demonstrating inappropriate behavior to leave the building and to assist other Site Hosts with guests who refuse to leave.
- General cleaning and maintenance of buildings including set-up and breakdown of site operations
- Identify safety and security issues and suggest possible solutions or alternatives.
- Work with staff to ensure all positions are covered
- Assist in HOP services, programs and activities
- Help with moving donations of food and clothing to appropriate storage and distribution areas
- Drive ministry van to pick up donations or make deliveries
- Identify safety and security issues and communicate them to Assistant Director
- Comply with Province and ministry policies, procedures, guidelines and standards

Qualifications: High School Diploma or equivalent, must be able to work a flexible schedule, effective problem solving, interpersonal and verbal communication skills, ability to travel locally, drive cargo van and to work outside in all types of weather, ability to be welcoming and professional.
