

Volunteer Coordinator

Responsibilities:

- Demonstrate, exemplify and support the Capuchin Charism and Provincial Mission, Vision and Values throughout all professional responsibilities and activities
- Develop and sustain a volunteer community that supports the program
- Coordinate with managers to identify and meet program operational needs and match opportunities with groups, individuals, and community service candidates
- Maintain and share on-line calendars for scheduling volunteers for all program activities
- Serve as site contact for individuals and groups
- Ensure all volunteers and community service candidates receive proper background checks, orientation, and training
- Collaborate with Public Relations and Development Offices to promote ministries and programs and engage existing and potential volunteers
- Sustain and develop connections with the faith-based and nonprofit direct service communities to collaborate about best practices
- Assist and attend in various annual events and celebrations
- Fill in as needed for various tasks including working in pantry or serving food
- Track and report volunteer activities to ministry staff as requested
- Comply with Province and ministry policies, procedures, guidelines, and standards

Qualifications: High School Diploma or GED, 2 years of experience in volunteer coordinator capacity or Associates Degree or combination of education and experience, experience in community engagement activities, effective MicroSoft office skills, ability to travel locally, ability to use Volunteer Hub or similar software.
